



Guideline for Poster Presentation

GENERAL

The poster session is based on a visual presentation of your research work and ideas. Present main points briefly and graphically. For better visibility, use of larger letter with gothic type (e.g., Arial) font is good for audiences to read the poster from a distance without over-crowding.

LANGUAGE AND UNITS

All posters must be in English. Use of SI units is strongly recommended. If you have to use non-SI units, please provide SI-equivalent values, i.e., 1.0mmAq (9.8Pa).

DIAGRAMS AND PHOTOGRAPHS

Use of diagrams, graphs and photographs makes your poster attractive. Photographs should have good contrast, sharp focus. Graphs and diagrams should be enlarged to be readable from a distance of 1 meter away.

POSTER SIZE AND APPEARANCE

Authors will be given an A0 (0.84 m wide x 1.19 m high) poster area. Panel area is 0.9 m wide and 2.1 m high. Please prepare your poster to fit within the poster area.

BRINGING YOUR POSTER

Please bring your poster with you. Conference organizer cannot receive your poster by postage mails nor by any other delivery means. We do not provide on-site poster printing service.

PLACING YOUR POSTER

The poster session will be scheduled in the afternoon of second day, 6th, Oct. However, to provide the symposium participants with chance to see your poster in advance, you are requested to place your poster earlier. The poster panel will be ready for placing your poster by the morning of first day, 5th, Oct. Please consider placing your poster in the first day of the symposium.

The panel allocated to your poster will be identified with an ID on the upper left part. Check your poster ID by the list of accepted posters on symposium webpage:

Materials to place your poster such as pins and tapes will be provided.

PRESENTATION.

We do not have “shot-gun presentation” so that presenting poster on your site is the only way to appeal your work. Be sure that at least one of the authors must be present during the poster session. Best poster award will be given to the excellent one(s). If no authors would be present, the poster shall be omitted from the list of award candidate. Items can be displayed in your site if necessary, however, be sure that we do not provide any additional facility such as desks, chairs, power-plug and so on.

REMOVING YOUR POSTER

It is recommended to keep your poster placed on panel until the end of symposium. This will provide participants with additional chance to see your poster. In addition, as the poster award is publicized at the closing ceremony, this will provide a chance to celebrate poster award winner. Please remove your poster yourself after closing ceremony. If the posters will have been left on the panel, they will be disposed after the symposium.
